Approval of Minutes

1. Administrative Assistant I, City Clerk's Office – approve passing score.

Staff requests that the Civil Service Commission establish a passing score for Administrative Assistant I in the City Clerk's Office at 54.7 percent. This will create a register with 78 candidates and no finding of adverse or disparate impact supported by the date. Commissioner Broom and Commissioner Knight approved and Commissioner Knight seconded approval.

2. Fire Engineer- Certify Register

Staff requests that the Civil Service Commission approve the promotional register for the position of Fire Engineer. This will result in a register consisting of 11 individuals valid for three years. The register is established using the criteria of seniority only. There is no testing process for this register. Commissioner Broom approved and Commissioner Knight seconded approval.

3. Rule 11.9 Revision

Staff requests Commission to approve the revision of Rule 11.9 by eliminating the language, "The discharged employee may not appeal the termination to the Commission for review unless in the judgment of the Commission, the employee's rights within these rules were infringed." Commissioner Broom approved and Commissioner Knight seconded approval.

4. Quarterly Activity Reported

Staff presented the Commission with a report of activity from May 1, 2012 – July 31, 2012 including hires, promotions, separations, pay rate changes and disciplinary actions.
