

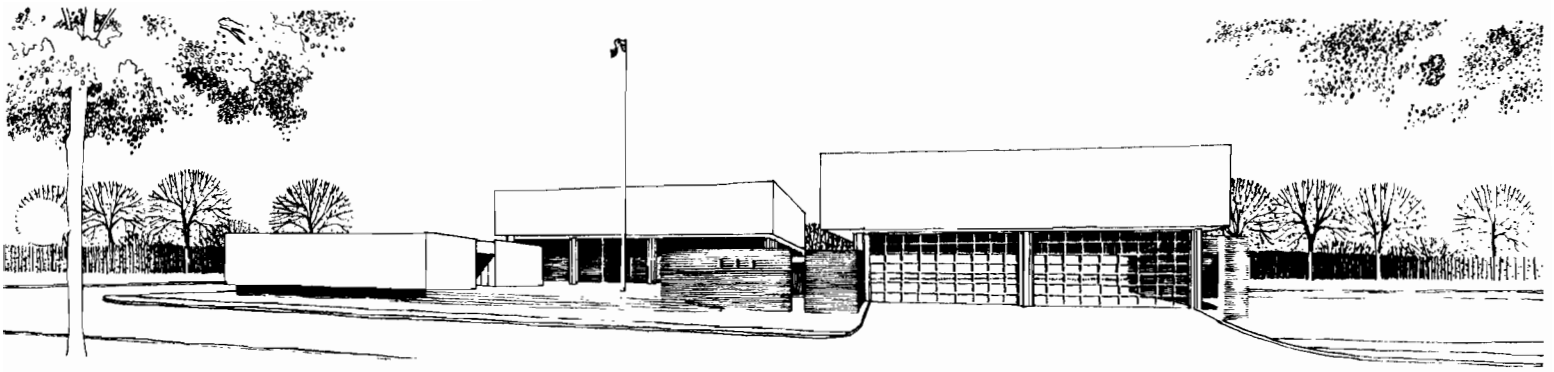
President Uden called meeting ~~to~~ order.
