In our 5th year, in 2005, we purchased the post office building and transformed it into a community media & arts center. The post office remains open here.



LIBRARIANS & ARCHIVISTS: Responsible for building and maintaining the IMC's progressive library project and archive of media materials; including a renowned zine collection. Not meeting currently. The library and zine collection is looking for a caretaker.

**BOOKS TO PRISONERS:** UC Books to Prisoners sends free books to Illinois prisoners based on their requests, created and staffs the Champaign County Jail library, and coordinates displays of prisoner artwork. **TECH:** Responsible for the tech and equipment needs of the Center, including the IMC website, computer networking and electronics, and the chambana.net community hosting server. **PRODUCTION:** Manages the IMC Production Studio. Schedules and facilitates audio, video, radio, and other multimedia projects and offers training in digital editing.
