The report includes information regarding projects which are in process, recent requests and recommendations from the public, staff activities, and upcoming events.

# **Update on Current Projects**

- Gallery District Incentive Program—Art Coop, Inc. in Lincoln Square is now open.
- Urbana Arts Grants Program—All but two of the 2009 Projects have been completed. Final Reports are being received and reviewed. Attached are reports from 40 North | 88 West, USD Elementary Fine Arts, and the IMC Children's Arts Fest. Most of the 2010 agreements have been finalized and are underway.
- Art at the Market: Art Workshops—The third art workshop of the season took place on July 31<sup>st</sup>. Traci Pines led a "Plastic Fantastic: Earth Friendly Printmaking" workshop. The next workshop will be led by Justine Bursoni on August 28<sup>th</sup>. - *Art Now!* UPTV Arts Program—The program continues to run on UPTV each Monday from 6:30pm 7:00pm.
- Fundraising—staff has continued to research potential policies. Attached is the policy developed for the City of Champaign regarding its fundraising activities related to its 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. This information should be considered when developing a policy for the Public Arts Program.
- Marketing: Staff is regularly updating the Facebook page which has 293 fans. Staff is also in the process of updating the Arts Guide and the Public Arts Program brochure. Additionally, the News Gazette featured an article on the Urbana Public Arts Program. The article ran in the Entertainment section on July 18, 2010.
