## Introduction

The following Urbana Public Arts Program Monthly Progress Report describes activities of the Public Arts Program for the Urbana Public Arts Commission. The report includes information regarding projects which are in process, recent requests and recommendations from the public, staff activities, and upcoming events.

## **Update on Current Projects**

- Urbana Arts Grants Program—Many of the 2010 projects have been completed and several are still yet to occur. Staff is preparing the 2011 grant cycle application materials and expect to release them in the next week. - Art at the Market: Art Workshops—The last two art workshop of the season took place on September 25<sup>th</sup> and October 30<sup>th</sup>. In September, Roberta Bennett led a "Mother Nature Mobile" workshop using sticks and seed pods to make hanging mobiles. In October, Jessica Roberts led a "Plantable Papermaking" workshop where participants turned discarded paper into new biodegradable paper with plant seeds. - City Building Exhibit Space—The Artist of the Corridor exhibit began on September 30th, featuring the watercolor work of Sandra Batzli. Her exhibit will be on display until November 30<sup>th</sup>.
