# **Background**

Every two years, the Urbana Public Arts Program collaborates with the Public Art League (PAL) and Urbana Public Works to install public artworks at various locations in Urbana. This cycle, Urbana welcomes five new sculptures that will stay in the community for a period of two years.

## **Update**

The following sculptures have been installed in downtown Urbana:

- 1. *Monolith* by Timothy Jorgensen was installed on November 2<sup>nd</sup>, at the southwest corner of the Champaign County Courthouse.
- 2. *A New Leaf* by Don Lawler was installed at Parking Lot 1, near the corner of Water Street and Broadway Avenue, on September 28<sup>th</sup>.
- 3. *The Horse and the Hound* by Jim Collins has been installed at the southwest corner of the Boneyard Creek Crossing on September 26<sup>th</sup>. The piece is sponsored by Mike Hosier.
- 4. *Keep It Together* by Benjamin Pierce has been installed at Leal Park by the Urbana Park District in late September. The sculpture is sponsored by Barak Rosenshine.

The last sculpture, *The Three Red Houses* by Andrew Arvanetes, will be installed at the Boneyard Creek Crossing on November 7<sup>th</sup>. *The Three Red Houses*, *Monolith*, and *A New Leaf* are sponsored by the City of Urbana.

Four sculptures that were installed two years ago have been removed: *Whirlwind in the Thorntree* by V. Skip Willits, *Twistah-Tous* by Bennett Wine, *Athirst* by Sarah Deppe, and *Asteray* by Nicole Beck. The last sculpture from the 2014-2016 cycle, *Maelstrom II* by Craig Snyder, will be removed on November 10<sup>th</sup>.
