Post-Project Evaluation:

We went "All Around This World" for our July 20 Folk and Roots Friday at the Lake House in Crystal Lake Park with help from the Urbana Public Arts program. World musician and children's music teacher Jay Sand and his three daughters entertained with songs and dances from several nations. Jay also came to Summer Arts Camp at the Phillips Center for a workshop with our campers, and performed a second family concert at the Urbana Free Library.

Our family concert's attendance wasn't as much as we hoped for as the weather looked dubious all morning and a large rain front passed just north of Urbana before the concert was to begin and we got a small amount of rain. The 40 people that attended very much enjoyed the program and Jay did a fantastic job getting the audience involved and participating in songs from African, Asian, and Latin American countries. His afternoon workshop made a big impression on the 41 arts campers and 8 staffers, who really enjoyed the journey into so many cool cultures. His interactive songs and instructions for crowd participation were the best! The library's concert had even fewer people, around 30. They didn't do any promotion for the program until the day of the show, but staff also said their free concert attendance had been declining.

UPD Program staff spent approximately 100 hours in staff meetings, communicating and planning with Jay, working on marketing materials, and setting up for the concert and workshops. Working with Jay was fantastic, he's a talented musician and lovely human. Attached are examples of marketing, receipts/invoices, and photos from the two UPD events.
