Water Resource Issues

- Surface Water and Storm Water Quality
- Flood Management
- Recreational Waters

Following brief conversation, it was determined that the next step in proceeding would be establishing baseline numbers for each category and selecting criteria to best assess and address the conditions of each category. Tess said that he would begin working towards that end.

Additionally, the Commission discussed ways in which to engage and educate the public in sustainable water practices.
