Additionally, Mr. Tess reported that staff is participating as a local partner in the University of Illinois Institute for Sustainability, Energy and the Environment capstone course for students to work on. Staff can provide support and mentorship.

U-Cycle is collaborating with the City of Champaign and Champaign County for the electronics recycling event and the Illinois EPA-sponsored household hazardous waste event to be held on two (2) Saturdays in October.

Mr. Tess also shared that staff attended a "Recycling in Transition" workshop in Springfield, where recycling coordinators around the state met to discuss the state of recycling in Illinois since the China ban took effect.

The next meeting is scheduled for November 5 at 7:00 pm in the Executive Conference Room at the Urbana City Building.
