Approval of Minutes:

New Business

Item #1- Discussion of the installation of a four-way stop at Trails Drive and Myra Ridge Drive.

Joe Smith stated that the results of the traffic study conducted at the intersection of Trails Drive and Myra Ridge Drive showed that the traffic volume did not warrant the installation of a fourway stop at the intersection. He indicated that there were 85 vehicles within an hour, which was not sufficient to warrant the installation of stop signs on Trails Drive.

Joe Smith moved to take no action on this item. Mike Bily seconded the motion. The motion was approved 2-0.

This item does not require Council action.

Item #2- Discussion of parking restrictions on Johnson Avenue.

Linda Fitzsimmons stated that she was in favor of parking restrictions on the west side of Johnson Avenue. She stated that the street was too narrow to accommodate parking on both sides of the street and allow traffic to pass.

Joe Smith moved to restrict parking on the west side of Johnson Avenue between Illinois Street and California Avenue.

Mike Bily seconded the motion.

The motion was approved 2-0.

This item will go to Council for consideration.

Joe Smith asked that the Commission look at parking restrictions on Johnson Avenue between California Avenue and Oregon Street at the August Traffic Commission meeting.

Mike Bily moved to cancel the July Traffic Commission meeting. Joe Smith seconded the motion. The Commission approved the motion 2-0.
