Chief Adair called the meeting to order at 5:38 p.m.

Chief Adair reported that there have been special details at Lakeside Terrace due to a rise in criminal activity in that area. However, he reported that recently Sunnycrest II in southeast Urbana had a higher rate of crime than Lakeside Terrace. Dunbar Court is relatively quiet right now. He also announced that he has chosen Jim Page as his Assistant Chief. After city council approval, Page's appointment will become official as of July 1, 2002.

Samuel Johnson announced that the next "Jettie Rhodes Day" will be held on Saturday, June 22, 2002 at noon at King Park.

Chief Adair addressed questions/concerns from committee members. Discussion followed.
