The meeting was called to order by John Cooper at 5:40 p.m.

Chief Adair reported that an arrest had been made in connection with a New Year's Eve homicide in Urbana, several drug arrests had been made at Europe Inn, and the Canopy Club dances held on Wednesday nights have become a problem because of fights, resulting in some arrests. The Chief also explained the Homeland Security Codes we have recently experienced and how these changes affect our community. Chief Adair addressed questions/concerns from committee members. Discussion followed.
