Chief Adair called the meeting to order at 5:40 p.m.

Bob Grewe from Urbana Community Development discussed the Spring Neighborhood Cleanup scheduled for Saturday, May 3, 2003. He distributed a memorandum written by Housing Rehabilitation Coordinator Randy Burgett summarizing the Fall 2002 Cleanup and addressing pertinent information about the upcoming Spring 2003 Cleanup. Due to cutbacks in funding, lunch will not be served at the May 3<sup>rd</sup> cleanup. Mr. Grewe circulated a sign-up sheet for volunteers and thanked the UCAP members for their continued support.

Samuel Johnson reported that a location for the Community Center has not been found. The owner of the property being considered for the center has decided not to sell the property at this time. This delay has slowed the progress of the Community Center plans for now.

Chief Adair reported that it has been relatively quiet locally, which has allowed time for additional officer training. He also reported that cuts have been made in this year's budget as well as next year's budget. Urbana residents, however, should not see any change in police services because of these cutbacks. Chief Adair addressed questions/concerns from committee members. Discussion followed.
