Acting Chief Bily discussed upcoming police officer recruiting sites and anticipated new hiring in the future for the department, as well as, the current status of recently hired officers attending PTI training and the FTO program. He reported that as a result of the new hires, the Street Crime Unit should be back in operation by June 2006. He also reported that interviews were held on March 15, 2006 to fill the position of Chief of Police.

Committee members and Acting Chief Bily discussed the need for continued police presence in the area. Members expressed their desire for UPD police officers to continue to address suspicious activity in the neighborhood in order to sustain the reduction of crime that has been realized in the last few years.
