AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING NOTICE TO THE
CITY OF URBANA OF DAMAGE TO CITY PROPERTY

WHEREAS, it appearing to the City Council of the City of Urbana that it is for the best interests of the People of the City of Urbana, and necessary for the protection of the public health and safety of its citizens that certain officers of the City be immediately notified of any damage to City property;

AND, WHEREAS, notice to proper officers of the City will permit more expeditious repair and maintenance of City property in the future.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

- Section 1. Any person, firm or corporation who shall either intentionally, willfully, negligently, or accidentally injure or damage any sewers, electric light cables, electric light standards, other electrical equipment, pavements, curbs, gutters, man holes, sidewalks, trees, automotive equipment, buildings or any other City property of any kind or description shall immediately notify either the Commissioner of Public Works or the City Electrician of the City of Urbana of the time, place, nature, and extent of such damage. In event neither of these officers is available at the time the notification is required, then the person so damaging said property shall immediately notify the Police Department of said damage.
- Section 2. The notification shall be made in writing upon forms to be furnished by the City Electrician and the Commissioner of Public Works, which said form shall also be available at the Police Station.
- Section 3. Any person, firm or corporation who shall hereafter damage property as set forth in Section 1, and shall fail to make the proper notification to the City as provided herein, shall be fined not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).
