ORDINANCE IN REFERENCE TO THE POLICE MAGISTRATE  
AND DUTIES AND COMPENSATION OF THE POLICE MAGISTRATE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, in reference to the Police Magistrate and the duties and compensation of the Police Magistrate from and after April 30, 1961, that the Police Magistrate is authorized and shall collect fines, fees, expenses, and costs for the City of Urbana, and similiar to the practices of the Justice of Peace of Champaign County, Illinois; and that all fines, fees, and costs assessed and collected by such Police Magistrate from and after April 30, 1961, shall be accounted for as required and paid into the funds of the City of Urbana, Illinois, a municipal corporation.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that a salary of \$10,000.00 is herewith established to be paid as an annual salary to the Police Magistrate for each fiscal year of the City of Urbana to be appropriated and disbursed from the fines, fees and costs collected by said Police Magistrate and remitted to the City of Urbana; and the said Police Magistrate is authorized to assess and collect fees or expenses in the appropriate cases; and


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Police Magistrate shall furnish from his salary or his own funds the secretarial and clerical assistance to and for the Police Magistrate; and the City shall furnish necessary office supplies and equipment and services in regard to the same, and the City shall furnish office space and necessary fixtures and utility services for the conduct of the Police Magistrate Court; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that the Police Magistrate shall


attend to the duties and functions of the Police Magistrate Court for all such Court business and whenever there is such business, and is subject to any and all calls of the City for necessary business of the Court and to set bonds and cases, and for the conduct of such cases when the same are set, and that the Police Magistrate shall conduct the cases and promptly account for the moneys collected and pay the same to the City promptly and in accordance with the laws, ordinances and statutes made and provided; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that this Ordinance shall be effective from the date of April 30, 1961.
