

DEBRIS REMOVAL ORDINANCE

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BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

The accumulation of useless junk and debris of practically no value is hereby declared to be a condition which is a public nuisance maintained by the owner or occupant of any property or agent of any non-resident property owner, *on and along public streets and alleys,* within the corporate limits of the City of Urbana, Illinois.

Every person who is the owner or occupant of property within the City, or the agent in charge of such property for a non-resident owner is charged with the duty of keeping such property free from useless junk and debris of practically no value, *and for public health and safety,* and each owner, occupant, or agent having charge of such property shall be notified in writing by the Commissioner of Public Works or Health Officer to remove such junk or debris. It shall be the duty of such occupant or agent to immediately remove such junk or debris and satisfactorily dispose of the same to the satisfaction of the Commissioner of Public Works or Health Officer, all within ten (10) days of receipt of the notice.

If any such owner, occupant or agent, upon receipt of such notice, shall fail to remove such junk and debris as mentioned in this ordinance, the City can cause such junk or debris removed to a satisfactory disposal, and charge a reasonable cost of such removal to the owner or occupant of the premises, and such owner or occupant is subject to penalty for such failure, neglect, or refusal as a violation of this ordinance.
