

ORDINANCE OF AMENDMENT TO THE CODE
OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, 1954,
ARTICLE 3, WASTE PAPER AND RUBBISH.

WHEREAS, during construction, excavation or hauling of dirt, mud, sand, gravel, crushed stone, and other such materials in trucks and other conveyances, such materials fall from trucks and other conveyances or come from wheels, dual wheels, tires, dual tires, and treads of tires of such trucks and vehicles, and such materials are deposited and scattered on and along the public streets of the City of Urbana, Illinois, and,

WHEREAS, the deposit and scatter of such materials on and along such public streets of said City create an uncleanly condition of such streets and the dispersal of mud, grit and dust on and along such streets;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

That the Code of the City of Urbana, Illinois, 1954, Article 3, Waste Paper and Rubbish, Division 1., in general, Chapter 14, be amended immediately after Section 14.12 to provide as follows:

Section 14.12 A. It shall be unlawful for any person to strew or scatter any substantial quantity of dirt, mud, sand, gravel, crushed stone, or other such material on the public streets of the City of Urbana and allow the same to remain. ~~NO EXEMPTIONS~~ Any violator shall be subject to the penalty of a fine in accordance with the said Code of the City of Urbana, Illinois, and is liable for the cost of removal of such material if so removed.
