

GRADE A PASTEURIZED MILK ORDINANCE WITH ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES
PURSUANT TO 1965 RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE UNITED STATES PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICE
ADOPTED AS THE ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois;
A Pasteurized Milk ordinance with administrative procedures pursuant to the
1965 recommendations of the United States Public Health Service, as amended,
is adopted as the ordinance of the City of Urbana, Illinois, which ordinance is
further entitled An ordinance defining "milk" and certain "milk products," "milk
producer," "pasteurization," etc.; prohibiting the sale of adulterated and mis-
branded milk and milk products; requiring permits for the sale of milk and
milk products; regulating the inspection of dairy farms and milk plants, and the
examination, labeling, pasteurization, distribution and sale of milk and milk
products; providing for the construction of future dairy farms and milk plants,
the enforcement of this Ordinance and the fixing of penalties.

Any person who shall violate any provision of this ordinance shall be
guilty of misdemeanor and upon conviction there of shall be subject the penalty
of fine of not more than \$200.00 for each violation. All ordinances and pro-
visions in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed. This ordinance
shall be in force and effect in ten days after the adoption approval and
publication of this adoptive ordinance.
