

RETIREMENT AGE ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA,
ILLINOIS:

Each non-elected regular employee of the City of Urbana, Illinois, whether employed on a permanent basis, or appointed on a yearly basis, shall retire by the next May 1 immediately following the attainment of the age of 70 years; provided, however, that each employee of the City of Urbana, Illinois, whether employed on a permanent basis or appointed on a yearly basis, who is either age 70 years or above at the time of the passage of this ordinance, or who attains the age of 70 years, between the date of the passage of this ordinance and May 1, 1969, shall retire by May 1, 1969;

Further provided, however, following the date of retirement as hereinbefore set forth, any city employee may be appointed by the Mayor on a yearly basis on approval of a three-fourths vote of all aldermen authorized to be elected.
