Section 20.94 of the Urbana City Code, be and is hereby amended, ^{to provide} as follows:

Every person who permits a vehicle to be parked overtime at a parking meter as provided in section 20.86 of this Code may, within twenty-four hours of the time when the notice required in section 20.93 of this Code was attached to such vehicle, pay as the penalty for, and in full satisfaction of such violation, the sum of one dollar (\$1.00) and within the next forty-eight hours the sum of one dollar (\$1.00). The failure of such person to make such payment within such seventy-two hours shall render such person subject to the penalties provided in section 1.6 of this Code.


