
AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL FORMER SECTION 11.12 OF THE
URBANA CITY CODE AND TO PROVIDE FOR A NEW SECTION
DEALING WITH CONTRACTS FOR
EXTRA TERRITORIAL FIRE PROTECTION

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, that the Mayor is authorized to execute contracts for the City to supply fire protection service to owners of properties which are outside of the corporate limits of the City, if and only if the property in question is so situated that the owner is unable to annex said property to the City. In considering whether the owner is able to annex the property in question the beneficial ownership of intervening property may be considered. Fees for such services shall be determined in accordance with Section 11.13 of this Code. Provided, however, that no structure outside of the City limits and more than three miles from the central fire station shall be served by City contracts or facilities without the approval of the City Council, and further provided no such contracts may be granted for areas which are presently situated so as to be able to be annexed into the City. The contracts for areas which have become annexable shall not be renewed.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor of the City of Urbana, and former Section 11.12 of the Urbana City Code is hereby repealed.


