

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE LIFE SAFETY CODE

WHEREAS, the National Fire Protection Association has hitherto published a Code formerly known as Building Exits Code, and

WHEREAS, the Building Exits Code has been republished by the National Fire Protection Association as Life Safety Code, 1970 edition, and

WHEREAS, three copies of the Life Safety Code, 1970 edition have been on file with the City Clerk for at least 15 days immediately preceding the adoption of this Ordinance,


THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. That Life Safety Code, 1970 edition, published by the said National Fire Protection Association, with all amendments thereto to date, is hereby and herewith adopted.

Section 2. That former Section 8.3 of Chapter 8 of the Urbana City Code be repealed upon the taking of effect of this Ordinance.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1 - 2 - 4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.


