

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 14.24 OF THE URBANA CITY CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS,

that:

Section 1. All of Section 14.24, as such presently is written, shall be deleted.

Section 2. A new Section 14.24 shall be inserted in place of the deleted Section 14.24 which shall read as follows:


"No garbage, trash or other materials shall be hauled from outside the city to the city dump from any commercial or industrial establishment outside the city limits, unless there is a contractual arrangement in this regard between the hauler and the city.

The Commissioner of Public Works of the city council is to determine what uses are residential, commercial or industrial.


Haulers can ascertain from month to month from the city the extent of the city limits."

Section 3. This Amendment shall take effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor of the City of Urbana, Illinois.

ORDINANCE NO. 7172-54A

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT PARKING ON LINCOLN AVENUE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS,


that:

1. It shall be unlawful and a violation of this Ordinance for any person to park any automobile on either side of Lincoln Avenue between Pennsylvania and Nevada Avenues.


2. The Parking Commission is hereby instructed to install or replace present meters on Nevada Avenue with at least the same number of 12 minute and 24 minute meters as were on Lincoln Avenue between Pennsylvania and Nevada prior to the taking effect of this Ordinance.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 4th day of October, 1971.
