

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE  
CODE REGULATING THE SALE AT RETAIL OF ALCOHOLIC  
LIQUORS WITHIN THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS,  
THAT:

Section 1. All of Section 16.22 of An Ordinance Code Regulating  
The Sale At Retail Of Alcoholic Liquors Within The City Of Urbana is hereby repealed  
upon this amendment taking effect.

Section 2. The following new sections are hereby enacted:

a) "16.22 Unlawful Loitering by Minors. It shall be unlawful  
for any person under the age of 21 to frequent or loiter in any  
place of business in the City where alcoholic liquors, except  
beer, are sold to be consumed on the premises.

b) "16.22 (a) Attempt to Purchase or Misrepresenting Age. It  
shall be unlawful for any person under the age of 21 to attempt  
to purchase alcoholic liquors or to misrepresent his or her age  
for the purpose of purchasing or receiving liquor.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its  
passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1 - 2 - 4 of the Illinois  
Municipal Code.
