

ORDINANCE NO. 7778-49

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 16.15
OF THE URBANA CITY CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA,
ILLINOIS, as follows:

That Section 16.15, entitled "Gasoline Service Station,
Prohibited", of Chapter 16, entitled "Intoxicating Liquor", of the
Urbana City Code, as amended, be and the same is hereby further
amended to now provide as follows:

Businesses Selling Motor Fuel, Prohibitions.

No license for the sale of alcoholic liquors shall be
issued to any person who, as a part of the business conducted on
the premises described in the application for such a liquor license,
sells or offers for sale from approved pumps, whether through an
attendant or by self-service, any motor fuel. As used in this
section, motor fuel shall include all volatile and inflammable
liquids which are produced, blended or compounded, or which are
suitable or practicable for, operating motor vehicles.

This ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote,
the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members
of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting
of said Council on the 16th day of January, 1978.
