

ORDINANCE NO. 7778-71

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE  
URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC ORDINANCE,  
AS AMENDED

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA,  
ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That Schedule VII, of Section 8-3, of Article VIII of the Urbana Local Traffic Ordinance, as amended, be and the same is hereby further amended by adding to that Schedule the following additional intersection where drivers of vehicles shall be required to stop before entering the intersection:

Florida	Eastbound at Anderson
Florida	Westbound at Anderson

Section 2. That Schedule I, of Section 5-2, of Article V of the Urbana Local Traffic Ordinance, as amended, be and the same is hereby further amended.

a) by deleting from that Schedule the following portion of a street where the state speed limit has heretofore been increased to 35 miles per hour:

Colorado	Between Philo and Vine

b) by adding to that Schedule the following portion of a street where the state speed limit shall hereafter be increased to 35 miles per hour:

Lincoln	Between Bradley and Sunset
---------	----------------------------

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 15th day of May, 1978.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code and when signs giving notice thereof are posted in accordance with Section 11-208-14(b) of the Illinois Vehicle Code.

Lincoln Between Bradley and Sunset

b) by adding to that Schedule the following portion of a street where the state speed limit shall hereafter be increased to 35 miles per hour:
