

AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING CHAPTER 16
OF THE URBANA CITY CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

That Section 16.18, entitled "Minor prohibited from
public areas of Class A establishments", of Chapter 16, entitled
"Intoxicating Liquor", of the Urbana City Code, as amended, be
and the same is hereby amended to now read as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any licensee of
a Class A license to permit or allow any person
under the age of 18 to frequent or remain in any
area within the licensee's place of business
which is open to the general public; provided
this section shall not apply to hotels, restaurants,
clubs, or bowling alleys. This section shall not
be deemed or construed, however, to require a licensee
of a Class A license to permit or allow any person
under the age of 21 to frequent or remain in any
area within the licensee's place of business which
is open to the general public. If any licensee of
a Class A license elects to permit or allow persons
under the age of 21 but at least the age of 18 to
frequent or remain in any public area pursuant to
the provisions of this section, or if any such
licensee elects to have any such area open, but
not open to the general public, the licensee shall
furnish prior written notice of such election,
including the time, date and place of the same
when and where applicable, to the liquor commissioner.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from
and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms
of Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

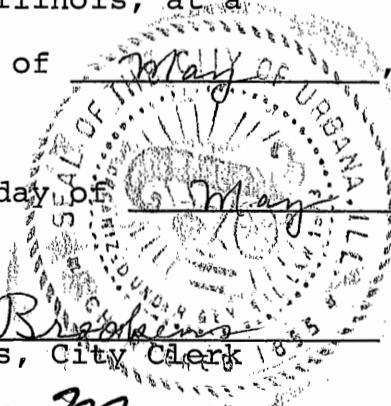
This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative

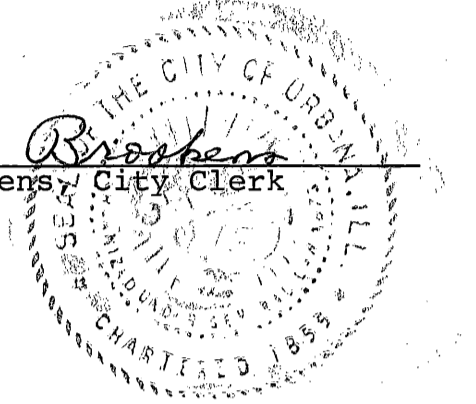

It shall be unlawful for any licensee of a Class A license to permit or allow any person under the age of 18 to frequent or remain in any area within the licensee's place of business which is open to the general public, provided this section shall not apply to hotels, restaurants, clubs, or bowling alleys. This section shall not be deemed or construed, however, to require a licensee of a Class A license to permit or allow any person under the age of 21 to frequent or remain in any area within the licensee's place of business which is open to the general public. If any licensee of a Class A license elects to permit or allow persons under the age of 21 but at least the age of 18 to frequent or remain in any public area pursuant to the provisions of this section, or if any such licensee elects to have any such area open, but not open to the general public, the licensee shall furnish prior written notice of such election, including the time, date and place of the same when and where applicable, to the liquor commissioner.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 19th day of May, 1980.
