

AN ORDINANCE
AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF VARIOUS AND
MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS OF PERSONAL PROPERTY
OWNED BY THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana, Illinois, owns the items of personal property specified below; and

WHEREAS, said described items have been determined to be of no further use to the City of Urbana by the City Departments heretofore utilizing such items; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the said listed items are no longer necessary or useful to, or for the best interests of the City of Urbana to retain.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That the following items of personal property be and the same are hereby authorized to be sold to the First National Bank of Champaign, Illinois, for a price of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) each:

Two (2) computer terminals (Serial Numbers 3277-H8156 and 3277-H8157).

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of three-fourths of the members of the corporate authorities of the City of Urbana, Illinois, then holding office.
