

ORDINANCE NO. 8081-3

AN ORDINANCE
APPROVING AN AGREEMENT FOR THE REMOVAL
OF RAILROAD TRACKS FROM CERTAIN STREET CROSSINGS
IN THE CITY OF CHAMPAIGN

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA,
ILLINOIS, as follows:

1. That An Agreement Between the City of Urbana and the City of Champaign for the Removal of Railroad Tracks From Certain Street Crossings in the City of Champaign, a copy of which said Agreement is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, be and the same is hereby approved.

2. That the Mayor of the City of Urbana, Illinois, be and the same is hereby authorized to execute said Agreement for and on behalf of the City of Urbana, Illinois.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a special meeting of said Council on the 14th day of July, 1980.

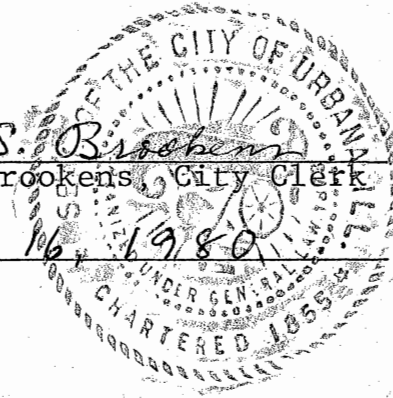

AN AGREEMENT

BETWEEN THE CITY OF URBANA AND THE CITY OF CHAMPAIGN
FOR THE REMOVAL OF RAILROAD TRACKS FROM
FROM CERTAIN STREET CROSSING IN
THE CITY OF CHAMPAIGN

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana, Illinois, a municipal corporation, hereinafter referred to as Urbana, proposes to relocate 2.9 miles of Norfolk and Western railroad trackage and abandon 26 railroad crossings, four of which are located within the City of Champaign, Illinois, hereinafter referred to as Champaign; and

WHEREAS, Urbana has secured Federal assistance to finance up to ninety percent of certain elements of the project cost and has as the "local agency" agreed to pay the local share requirement for said assistance; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed proper and in the best interests of its citizens for Champaign to pay the local share and other costs that would normally have been paid by Urbana for the restoration of the street surface for those crossings which are located within the Champaign corporate limits.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. Urbana agrees to perform surveys, prepare plans and specifications, and cause the improvement to be constructed in accordance with the said plans and specifications.

2. Urbana agrees to bid or cause the project to be bid and upon initiation of the work by contract to make all progress payments and the final payment due in conjunction with the local share of the project costs as required by any agreement with the State of Illinois.

3. Urbana agrees to furnish or cause to be furnished all construction engineering and inspection personnel required to satisfactorily administer the construction contract and assure close conformance to the plans and specifications for the improvement.

4. Champaign agrees to reimburse Urbana for the local share of the project costs related to the restoration of the street surface in the area from which the tracks were removed for the following street crossings:

- Fifth Street
- Washington Street
- Fourth Street
- Poplar Street

The amount to be reimbursed for the four crossings shall in no case exceed that which is indicated in the following costs:

Preliminary engineering	\$ 265
Construction engineering	\$ 615
Construction	<u>\$1230</u>
TOTAL	\$2110

5. This Agreement and the covenants contained herein shall become null and void in the event the work proposed herein is not completed by January 1, 1982.

6. This Agreement shall be binding and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto, their successors and assigns.
