

RESOLUTION NO. 2007-07-016R

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING RATIFICATION OF A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT  
WITH THE INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF FIRE FIGHTERS (IAFF)  
FOR THE TERM OF JULY 1, 2007 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2010**

WHEREAS, the duly authorized representatives of the City of Urbana in good faith have negotiated a three-year collective bargaining agreement ("Agreement") with Local No. 1147 of the International Association of Fire Fighters ("IAFF") concerning wages, hours, terms, and other conditions of employment for the term of July 1, 2007, through June 30, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement, which is attached hereto as Exhibit A ("Agreement Between the City of Urbana, Illinois and Local #1147 of the International Association of Firefighters for the Term Beginning July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2010"), has been lawfully and properly ratified by the membership of the IAFF; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council find that the best interests of the City are served by executing the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Urbana, Champaign County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. The City Council hereby ratifies the negotiated three-year collective bargaining agreement between the City of Urbana and Local No. 1147 of the IAFF.

Section 2. The Mayor and the City Clerk are authorized to execute said collective bargaining agreement on behalf of the City of Urbana and to execute any other documents necessary to carry out the intent and purpose of said agreement and this Resolution.

Section 3. The City Clerk shall transmit a certified copy of this Resolution to Trent Short, President, Local No. 1147 of the IAFF.

Section 4. The City Council authorizes disbursement of all necessary retroactive pay as provided in the collective bargaining agreement.
