

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-04-033R

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF
A GRANT FOR MARKET AT THE SQUARE**

(U.S. Department of Agriculture – Pandemic Relief and Protection Program - 2022)

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana (the “City”) is a home rule unit of local government pursuant to Article VII, Section 6, of the Illinois Constitution, 1970, and may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, and the passage of this Resolution constitutes an exercise of the City’s home rule powers and functions as granted in the Illinois Constitution, 1970; and

WHEREAS, the City operates a farmers market known as “Market at the Square” (the “Market”) from early May through October; and

WHEREAS, the City has in one or more years accepted funds from various grants, in order to fund the Market; and

WHEREAS, USDA has offered a grant (“Grant”) in the amount of \$11,099 to allow the City to be reimbursed for supplies to keep the market open and operating safely during the COVID 19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the City is willing to accept the Grant on the terms and conditions provided by USDA.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council, of the City of Urbana, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the USDA Pandemic Relief and Protection Program grant shall be accepted by the City and that the City shall abide by the terms and conditions provided in the exhibit attached hereto and made a part hereof.





