1. That the proposed improvement shall consist of

Asphalt resurfacing with roadway rehabilitation for Springfield Avenue from Wright Street to McCullough Street, excluding a segment from Gregory Street to Coler Avenue. The Original Resolution covered initial design engineering fee. This Supplemental Resolution is intended to cover the remainder of design engineering fee, construction engineering fee, and construction costs.

2. That there is hereby appropriated the sum of one million four hundred ninety thousand and 00/100

Dollars (\$1,490,000.00) for the improvement of said section from the Local Public Agency's allotment of Motor Fuel Tax funds.
